June 14, 1953 - August 16, 2026

Lydia Carmen Orozco died in Chicago on August 16, 2026. She was 73. Born on June 14, 1953, raised among Mexican-American manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She drove routes that were also neighborhoods. A transfer punch worn smooth marked years; riders knew her by the way she waited for the elderly. Colleagues still mention a transfer punch worn smooth.

She married Hector in 1979. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Hector died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Chicago, among streets she never needed to explain. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.
