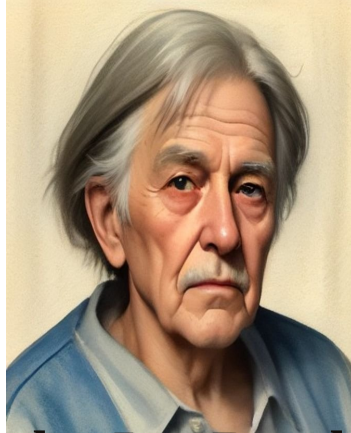




Malcolm Ian Boudreaux

December 15, 1943 - September 8, 2026

Rockford, Illinois

Malcolm Ian Boudreaux died in Rockford on September 8, 2026. He was 82. Born in Rockford on December 15, 1943, raised among Cajun French manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He drove routes that were also neighborhoods. A transfer punch worn smooth marked years; riders knew him by the way he waited for the elderly. Colleagues still mention a transfer punch worn smooth.

He married Margaret in 1966. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Margaret died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Rockford, among streets he never needed to explain. The radio is still tuned to the station that played while work got done.
