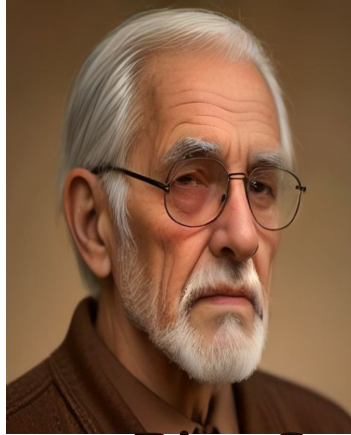




Marcus Dino Quilici

March 12, 1941 - August 3, 2026

Birmingham, Alabama

Marcus Dino Quilici died in Birmingham on August 3, 2026. He was 85. Born in Birmingham on March 12, 1941, into a Italian-American household that treated work as a language. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He spent decades walking catwalks above furnaces that made their own weather, reading a breaker panel the way other men read a newspaper. When a line went dark he arrived without drama, tracing fault to fuse, fuse to the quiet that meant payday would still come. Colleagues still mention a spare fuse drawer labeled in pencil.

He married Maria in 1963. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Maria died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Birmingham, among streets he never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.

Services
