March 11, 1942 - August 3, 2026

Birmingham, Alabama

Marcus Earl Albright died in Birmingham on August 3, 2026. He was 84. Born in Birmingham on March 11, 1942, raised among African American manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He spent decades walking catwalks above furnaces that made their own weather. When a line went dark he arrived without drama, tracing fault to fuse. Colleagues still mention a spare fuse drawer labeled in pencil.

He married Louise in 1965. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Louise died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Birmingham, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
