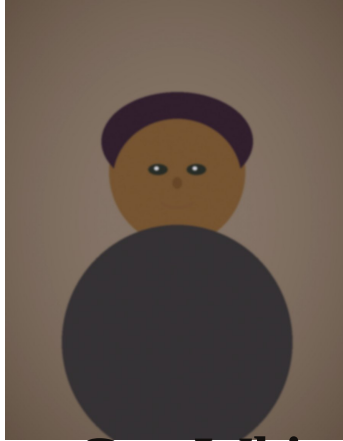




Marilyn Gay Whisenhunt

October 24, 1934 - July 15, 2026

Omaha, Nebraska

Friends in Omaha remember Marilyn Gay Whisenhunt, who died on July 15, 2026 at 91. Born in Omaha on October 24, 1934; Welsh-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. Young, she understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

She read bids that decided ownership without needing a speech. A ringman cane chalk stub with frank notes rebuilt more trust than lawyers. Colleagues still mention a ringman cane chalk stub.

She married Edward in 1959. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters and a son through public schools and ordinary weather. After Edward died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. She preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Omaha was home enough that she never rehearsed an introduction. The lunch pail still waits by the back door.
