Marjorie Lou Krawitz, 93, of Green Bay, died on August 15, 2026. Born in Green Bay on April 22, 1933; Basque-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. She learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

She turned rooms into readiness for strangers who would not stay. A linen sorter ticket spindle taught that small mercies matter. Colleagues still mention a linen sorter ticket spindle.

She married Thomas in 1958. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Thomas died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Green Bay, among streets she never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
