



## Milan Karel Novacek

*November 8, 1942 - September 6, 2026*

Omaha, Nebraska

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Milan Karel Novacek died in Omaha on September 6, 2026. He was 83. Born in Omaha on November 8, 1942, into a Czech-American household that treated work as a language. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He kept a line moving without treating people as parts. A stopwatch lived in his pocket unused; fairness was the real tempo. Colleagues still mention a stopwatch he never needed to wind.

He married Helena in 1967. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Helena died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Omaha, among streets he never needed to explain. The radio is still tuned to the station that played while work got done.
