Family and neighbors in Houston mark the death of Milton Joseph Galliard on August 22, 2026. He was 84. Born on July 1, 1942 and raised among French-American manners that never needed a speech. Young, he understood that quiet competence outlasts loud plans.

He edged tallies until waste stopped being an option. A lumber crayon stub decided what the yard could sell. Colleagues still mention a lumber crayon stub.

He and Sandra married in 1969 and raised four children without needing an audience. After Sandra's death in 2019, he held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Houston, on streets that already knew his pace. The porch still expects a returning step.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
