



Miriam Leah Goldstein

May 2, 1943 - August 21, 2026

Akron, Ohio

Miriam Leah Goldstein died in Akron on August 21, 2026. She was 83. Born on May 2, 1943, into a Jewish American household that treated work as a language. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She fielded parents, principals, and lost lunch money with the same calm. A drawer of hall passes held kindness; children learned her desk was safe. Colleagues still mention a drawer of hall passes and kindness.

She married Samuel in 1965. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Samuel died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Akron, among streets she never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.

A memorial gathering in Akron with coffee afterward. In lieu of flowers, a gift to a local workers' fund, clinic, or neighborhood library is welcome.
