December 3, 1949 - September 2, 2026

Jonesboro, Arkansas

Miriam Leah Rosenzweig died in Jonesboro on September 2, 2026. She was 76. Born on December 3, 1949, with Jewish American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She fielded parents, principals, and lost lunch money with the same calm. A drawer of hall passes held kindness; children learned her desk was safe. Colleagues still mention a drawer of hall passes and kindness.

She married Aaron in 1971. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two daughters through public schools and ordinary weather. After Aaron died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Jonesboro, among streets she never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
