



Moshe Aaron Landry

June 18, 1951 - August 8, 2026

Santa Fe, New Mexico

Moshe Aaron Landry died in Santa Fe on August 8, 2026. He was 75. Born on June 18, 1951, with Jewish-Cajun roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He opened before dawn and closed after the last bus. A stool behind the counter wore smooth under his patience. Colleagues still mention a stool behind the counter worn smooth.

He married Leah in 1976. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Leah died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Santa Fe, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
