Nadia Farah Delacroix died in Charlotte on September 2, 2026. She was 71. Born in Charlotte on February 10, 1955, into a Lebanese-Franco household that treated work as a language. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She counted, labeled, and double-checked with a care that kept wards safe. A pill-count tray polished smooth was her quiet instrument. Colleagues still mention a pill-count tray polished smooth.

She married Omar in 1979. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Omar died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Charlotte, among streets she never needed to explain. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.
