Nadia Farah Iskandar died in Charlotte on September 1, 2026. She was 71. Born on February 11, 1955, raised among Lebanese-American manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She counted, labeled, and double-checked with a care that kept wards safe. A pill-count tray polished smooth was her quiet instrument. Colleagues still mention a pill-count tray polished smooth.

She married Omar in 1977. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Omar died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Charlotte, among streets she never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
