November 3, 1940 - September 6, 2026

Burlington, Vermont

Nadine Claire Beaumont died in Burlington on September 6, 2026. She was eighty-five. Born there on November 3, 1940, she grew up knowing the lake as a workday neighbor, not a postcard, and she learned a ledger before she learned a highway. A correct date, she said, is a form of honesty.

She spent thirty-six years as a town clerk, first filing dog licenses, later keeping the minutes that told a village which road had been promised and which one had only been discussed. She treated a long line as weather. When the state put in a machine that was supposed to replace a person, she learned the machine and then taught it manners. She retired with a pin and a cake she tried to leave early.

She married Hugh Beaumont in 1963. He taught shop and died in 2007. They raised a son and a daughter in a flat that smelled of wool and maple. Nadine kept the walk to the waterfront and the habit of bringing extra mittens to town meeting in March. She read the local paper with a pencil and voted in every storm.

Neighbors remember a woman who remembered your return trip to the counter, who brought whoopie pies at Town Meeting without announcing a tradition, and who could sit through a nor'easter warning without making it a personality. She loved a library sale, a good cup of coffee that was never quite hot enough, and the late light on the islands. She died in Burlington, in the cold air she had always said you could live with if you buttoned your coat. The window is someone else's now. The patience she practiced there is harder to replace than a schedule.

Services

A service in Burlington, then coffee if the weather allows. A gift to the public library or a town meeting scholarship suits her.

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
