



Noelani Grace Palakiko

October 2, 1957 - September 4, 2026

Lihue, Hawaii

Noelani Grace Palakiko died in Lihue on September 4, 2026. She was sixty-eight. Born there on October 2, 1957, she grew up knowing trade wind as a neighbor that never slept, and she learned a laundry cart before she learned a highway. A clean sheet, she said, is a kind of welcome that does not require a speech.

She spent twenty-four years in a hotel laundry that fed rooms before daylight, first as a helper, later as the woman who could hear a tired extractor before the logbook admitted it. She did not advertise. Managers called her because she would scrap a load even when the truck was already promised. She kept extra towels for the clerk whose morning had already been too long. She charged a fair hour on the side when a church supper needed more mercy than a price list.

She married Keoni Palakiko in 1981. They raised a son and a daughter in a bungalow that needed a new roof more often than the budget admitted. Keoni worked the harbor. Noelani packed lunches that could survive humidity. After a bad afternoon she sat in the car with the radio off until her hands were quiet.

Friends remember a woman who brought extra rice to a night shift without staying for thanks, who knew which intern needed a second explanation, and who hummed while she worked as if the dryer were a conversation. She loved a late-afternoon beach that tourists had already left, a clean map of the linen rack, and the particular quiet after the last cart. She died in Lihue, in the weather she had always preferred to a mainland cold. The laundry still opens. Someone else will count the carts.
