March 19, 1938 - September 3, 2026

Orlando, Florida

Opal Jean Isenberg died in Orlando on September 3, 2026. She was 88. Born in Orlando on March 19, 1938, with Jewish American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She plated banquets that had to look inevitable. A whisk bent from decades of sauce still lived by the stove. Colleagues still mention a whisk bent from decades of sauce.

She married Clarence in 1961. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Clarence died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Orlando, among streets she never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.
