



Pauline Lynn Quisenberry

October 28, 1946 - July 17, 2026

Providence, Rhode Island

Family and neighbors in Providence mark the death of Pauline Lynn Quisenberry on July 17, 2026. She was 79. Born October 28, 1946 in Providence, carrying Brazilian-American stories that arrived without footnotes. She learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

She watched gauges that kept towns from inventing thirst. A filter logbook with careful ink was gospel in small print. Colleagues still mention a filter logbook with careful ink.

She and Carl married in 1973 and raised a daughter and two sons without needing an audience. After Carl's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Providence, on streets that already knew her pace. The porch still expects a returning step.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
