



Pearl Irene Iglesias

May 12, 1936 - August 29, 2026

Biloxi, Mississippi

Pearl Irene Iglesias died in Biloxi on August 29, 2026. She was 90. Born in Biloxi on May 12, 1936, with Cuban-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She sold bread and patience in equal measure. A flour-dusted apron waited on a hook; regulars came for rolls and left with advice. Colleagues still mention a flour-dusted apron on a hook.

She married Clarence in 1963. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Clarence died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a porch light left on for anyone walking home late. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Biloxi, among streets she never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.
