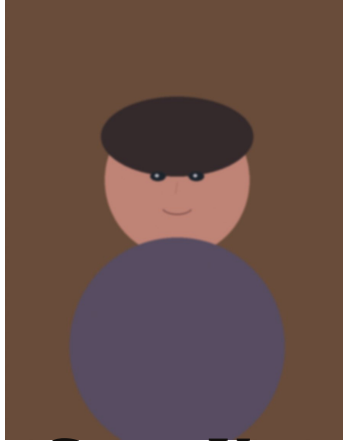




Phyllis Grace Kuznetsova

April 18, 1937 - August 23, 2026

Great Falls, Montana

Phyllis Grace Kuznetsova died in Great Falls on August 23, 2026. She was 89. Born in Great Falls on April 18, 1937, into a Russian-American household that treated work as a language. She learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

She counted ore under a sun that ignored manifests. A dock chalk pouch marked what the crane had already decided. Colleagues still mention a dock chalk pouch.

She and Ronald married in 1961 and raised a daughter and two sons without needing an audience. After Ronald's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember a shovel borrowed and returned sharper. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Great Falls, on streets that already knew her pace. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
