February 8, 1945 - September 6, 2026

Bangor, Maine

Rafael Antonio Cabrera died in Bangor on September 6, 2026. He was 81. Born in Bangor on February 8, 1945, raised among Cuban-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He ran a line that never forgave a slow morning. A hairnet washed every night was pride; piece rates never erased dignity. Colleagues still mention a hairnet washed every night as pride.

He married Carmen in 1968. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Carmen died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Bangor, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.
