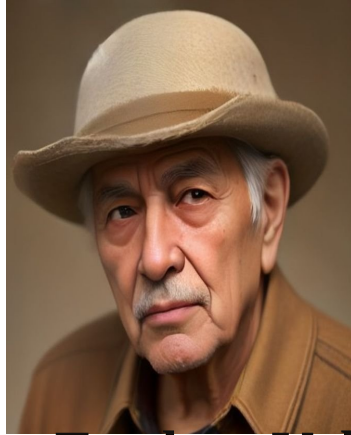




Ramiro Esteban Velasquez

November 4, 1952 - August 19, 2026

Tucson, Arizona

Ramiro Esteban Velasquez died in Tucson on August 19, 2026. He was 73. Born in Tucson on November 4, 1952, into a Mexican-American household that treated work as a language. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He rode the ditches before sunrise, opening gates and closing them with a farmer's arithmetic. Water was not poetry to him; it was a schedule you kept so cotton and pecan trees did not argue with the sky. Colleagues still mention a canvas hat bleached the color of river sand.

He married Lupe in 1977. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Lupe died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a rake leaned against a shared fence after a storm. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Tucson, among streets he never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.
