



Ray Ellis Honeycutt

June 22, 1938 - August 14, 2026

Flagstaff, Arizona

Ray Ellis Honeycutt died in Flagstaff on August 14, 2026. He was 88. Born in Flagstaff on June 22, 1938, raised among Scotch-Irish manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He restored cars that carried other people's years. A spray booth mask hung on a hook; estimates were frank, and so were apologies. Colleagues still mention a spray booth mask on a hook.

He married Donna in 1964. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised three children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Donna died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember quiet help with a stuck mailbox or a heavy trash can. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Flagstaff, among streets he never needed to explain. The garden will come up next spring without being told.
