



Raymond Lee Woolweaver

July 11, 1930 - June 23, 2026

Tucson, Arizona

Friends in Tucson remember Raymond Lee Woolweaver, who died on June 23, 2026 at 95. Born on July 11, 1930 and raised among Irish-American manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He cut ice into honesty that grocery boxes could trust. Ice tongs with a leather grip oiled weekly preferred work over speeches. Colleagues still mention an ice tongs leather grip oiled weekly.

He married Margaret in 1955. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Margaret died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Tucson was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.
