January 26, 1953 - August 15, 2026

Jacksonville, Florida

Rosa Elena Izquierdo died in Jacksonville on August 15, 2026. She was 73. Born in Jacksonville on January 26, 1953, with Cuban-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She ran floors that never slept. A checklist in two languages kept standards; she taught that a made bed is a small mercy. Colleagues still mention a cart checklist in two languages.

She married Miguel in 1976. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Miguel died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember a wave from the driveway that meant you were seen. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Jacksonville, among streets she never needed to explain. The garden will come up next spring without being told.
