Russell Gene Niedermayer, 90, of Phoenix, died on August 21, 2026. Born January 9, 1936 in Phoenix, carrying Belgian-American stories that arrived without footnotes. From the start, he treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

He edged kiln schedules until waste stopped being an option. A kiln moisture card decided what the yard could sell. Colleagues still mention a kiln moisture card.

He and Martha married in 1963 and raised three sons without needing an audience. After Martha's death in 2019, he held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember snow shoveled past the corner that was not required. He preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Phoenix was home enough that he never rehearsed an introduction. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
