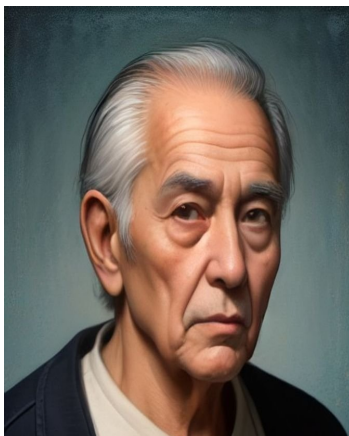




Salvador Reyes Salcedo

September 1, 1946 - August 28, 2026

Fresno, California

Salvador Reyes Salcedo died in Fresno on August 28, 2026. He was 79. Born on September 1, 1946, with Mexican-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He walked the rows at first light, reading leaves for stress and sugar. Crews trusted his hand signals more than any radio, and he never raised his voice when a season got tight. Colleagues still mention pruning shears hung by the back door.

He married Rosa in 1970. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised four children through public schools and ordinary weather. After Rosa died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Fresno, among streets he never needed to explain. The chair by the window still holds the shape of a habit.
