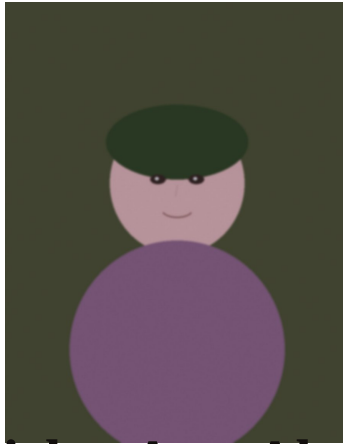




Shirley Ann Aberle

October 20, 1959 - August 24, 2026

Charleston, West Virginia

Shirley Ann Aberle, 66, of Charleston, died on August 24, 2026. Born in Charleston on October 20, 1959, into a German-American household that treated work as a language. Early on, she decided that a paycheck and a handshake should weigh the same.

She tended frames that sang and snagged in the same hour. A carding comb in felt lived in her apron forever. Colleagues still mention a carding comb in felt.

In 1982 she married Robert. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and two sons walked to school in weather that did not care. When Robert died in 2019, she kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. She preferred the hour before a town fully wakes. Charleston was home enough that she never rehearsed an introduction. The calendar still has a circle on payday.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
