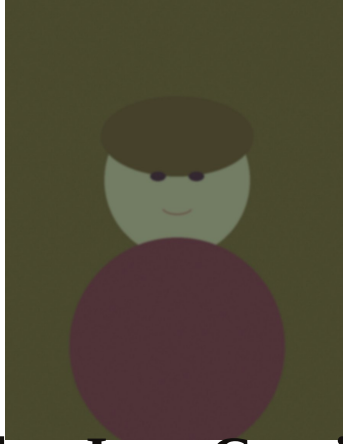




Shirley Jean Carrizales

October 12, 1941 - June 14, 2026

Spokane, Washington

Family and neighbors in Spokane mark the death of Shirley Jean Carrizales on June 14, 2026. She was 84. Born in Spokane on October 12, 1941; Salvadoran-American cooking and payday thrift set the tone of the house. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She kept scales that turned refuse into wages without inventing numbers. A dump scale chalk eraser ended arguments more gently than bosses. Colleagues still mention a dump scale chalk eraser.

She married Robert in 1966. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a daughter and two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Robert died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember the radio low on a Saturday while repairs got done. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Spokane, on streets that already knew her pace. The porch still expects a returning step.
