Sofia Isabel OSullivan died in Madison on August 10, 2026. She was 73. Born in Madison on May 17, 1953, raised among Irish-Latino manners that never needed a speech. She learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

She fed students who forgot to eat and faculty who forgot manners. A bent soup ladle was her scepter. Colleagues still mention a soup ladle bent from decades.

She married Miguel in 1979. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised two sons through public schools and ordinary weather. After Miguel died in 2019, she kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. She liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. She died in Madison, among streets she never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
