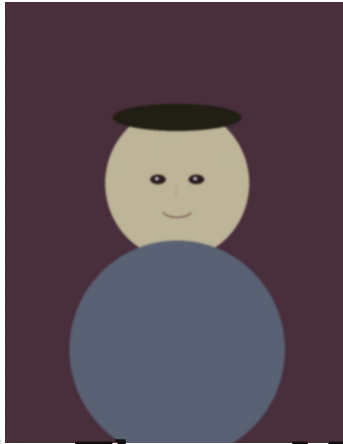




Stanley Thomas Moretti

July 24, 1946 - August 20, 2026

Hilo, Hawaii

Stanley Thomas Moretti, 80, of Hilo, died on August 20, 2026. Born in Hilo on July 24, 1946, into a Italian-American household that treated work as a language. From the start, he treated promises like tools: keep them sharp, do not lend them lightly.

He shaved roads until washboards stopped arguing with axles. A grader blade wrench tagged twice left the next hand something to trust. Colleagues still mention a grader blade wrench tagged twice.

In 1969 he married Judy. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and two daughters walked to school in weather that did not care. When Judy died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember someone who knew every child's name on the block. Mornings were his favorite shift at home. He died in Hilo, on streets that already knew his pace. The calendar still has a circle on payday.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
