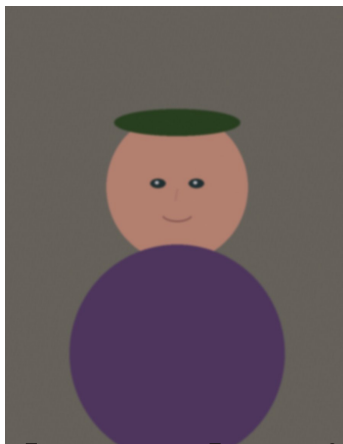




# Theodore Dale Winslett

*January 6, 1940 - September 13, 2026*

Concord, New Hampshire

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Theodore Dale Winslett died in Concord on September 13, 2026. He was 86. Born January 6, 1940 in Concord, carrying English-American stories that arrived without footnotes. He learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

He lasted shoes until lasts looked like invitations, not machines. A lasting hammer with initials rode the bench like company. Colleagues still mention a lasting hammer with initials.

In 1966 he married Kathy. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and one son and three daughters walked to school in weather that did not care. When Kathy died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Concord, among streets he never needed to explain. The extra coffee is still in the thermos.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
