Vera Joy Brouillard of Denver died on September 15, 2026 at the age of 91. Born on April 26, 1935, with African-American roots that shaped the table more than the flag. She learned that neighborhoods remember who helps without being asked.

She kept labels honest when harvest pressed the clock. A label-gun spare roll in a tin meant tomorrow would not invent grades. Colleagues still mention a label-gun spare roll in a tin.

She and George married in 1959 and raised four children without needing an audience. After George's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Denver, on streets that already knew her pace. The recipe card is still stained in the useful places.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
