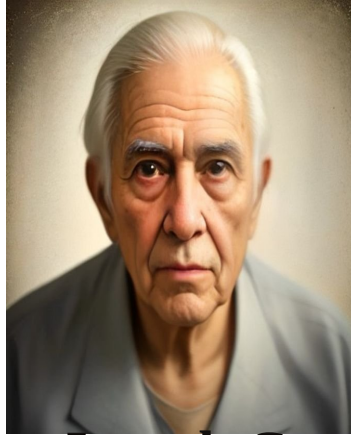




Victor Joseph Carmona

May 16, 1945 - September 3, 2026

Casper, Wyoming

On September 3, 2026, Victor Joseph Carmona died at home in Casper. He was 81. Born on May 16, 1945 and raised among Puerto Rican manners that never needed a speech. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He counted boxes under a sun that ignored manifests. A checker chalk pouch marked what the crane had already decided. Colleagues still mention a checker chalk pouch.

In 1971 he married Sharon. The marriage was not a speech; it was groceries, repairs, and two daughters walked to school in weather that did not care. When Sharon died in 2019, he kept what still worked: the early walk, the small garden, the call on Sundays.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Casper, among streets he never needed to explain. The porch still expects a returning step.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
