Virginia Kay Arredondo of Green Bay died on February 8, 2026 at the age of 82. She was born on April 22, 1943 in a Colombian-American family that measured love in finished chores. She grew up believing that showing up was the first craft.

She kept air that held funerals and festivals with equal care. An organ bellows leather patch kit meant the hall would not look abandoned. Colleagues still mention an organ bellows leather patch kit.

She and Richard married in 1967 and raised three daughters without needing an audience. After Richard's death in 2019, she held to quiet habits-coffee before dawn, a tended yard, a voice on the phone that still checked in.

Neighbors remember covered dishes that arrived without a speech. Mornings were her favorite shift at home. She died in Green Bay, on streets that already knew her pace. The tools are still hung where a hand can find them in the dark.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. Her life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
