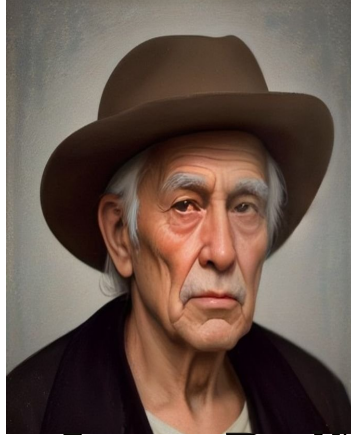




Walter James Redfeather

June 22, 1950 - August 24, 2026

Tulsa, Oklahoma

Walter James Redfeather died in Tulsa on August 24, 2026. He was 76. Born on June 22, 1950, with Cherokee roots that shaped the table more than the flag. He learned early that a day is something you finish, not something you wait for.

He fitted pipe in heat that taught humility. Wrenches hung by length on a board he built; leaks were personal insults. Colleagues still mention a pipe wrench hung by length.

He married Alice in 1974. They kept a house that stayed modest when the neighborhood did not. They raised a son and a daughter through public schools and ordinary weather. After Alice died in 2019, he kept the routines that still made sense: the walk, the garden, the Sunday call.

Neighbors remember coffee offered before questions. He liked early mornings before the heat or the noise. He died in Tulsa, among streets he never needed to explain. The key is still under the same brick.

What remains is not a legend but a practice: showing up, keeping a promise, leaving a place better than you found it. His life was the kind America is built from and too often forgets to name.
