



Wilma June Sether

August 13, 1947 - September 6, 2026

Bend, Oregon

Wilma June Sether died in Bend on September 6, 2026. She was seventy-nine. Born there on August 13, 1947, she grew up knowing timber as a rumor that paid and a motel key as a set of honest problems. Her mother cleaned rooms at a motor court. Wilma learned that a clean sink is a kind of welcome that does not require a speech.

She spent twenty years at a small motel off the highway, first making beds, later keeping the night desk for people who arrived late from the desert with a child asleep in the back seat. She kept extra blankets without putting a note on the counter about generosity. When a storm closed the pass she made coffee until the urn complained. Later she sold sandwiches at a park concession and treated a long line of tourists as weather you could live with if you kept moving.

She married Ruben Sether in 1969. They raised a daughter in a bungalow that needed a new roof more often than the budget admitted. Ruben worked the mill. Wilma packed lunches that could survive a climb in altitude. After he died in 2015 she kept his chair for a year and then gave it to a nephew who needed a place to do homework.

Neighbors remember a woman who would jump a battery in the motel lot at dusk, who knew which intern needed a second explanation of the register, and who could hear a rice pot without looking. She loved the first snow on the peaks, a green-chile burrito on a Saturday, and the particular quiet after the last key was returned. She died in Bend, in thin air she had always preferred to a heavy heat. The desk is someone else's now. The patience she practiced there is harder to replace than a vacancy sign.
