The only clock

The City of Longview posted that the City Council will hold a public hearing at its regular meeting starting at 6:00 p.m., October 8, 2026, in the Council Chambers at 1525 Broadway Street, to consider changes to current Transportation Benefit District funding to support future street and road capital projects and maintenance. The same notice carries a Zoom link. Any person may appear for or against.

Longview sits in Cowlitz County. The publisher of this register is in Oregon, across the Columbia. That is geography, not a brief. A city TBD hearing is still a public hour. It is not the county six-year TIP already dated in Port Townsend.

What a Transportation Benefit District is

A TBD is a local streets-funding vehicle. The hearing is the hour the Council takes comment on how that vehicle's money may be aimed. It is not the levy election. It is not the contractor's notice to proceed. Keep the files on separate lines.

Closing

Thursday, October 8, 2026, 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, 1525 Broadway Street, Longview. That is when the city posted that it will hear the streets money. Come for the funding line. Do not ask this paper to pour it.

*A hearing on streets-tax money is a public hour in a named chamber. It is not a bid. Date Broadway.
Leave the river on the plate.*
